Spaces & Places: Where We Create is an art therapy community photo documentary project developed by Magdalena Karlick, ATR, LPAT, LPCC and Gretchen Miller, MA, ATR-BC inviting participants to submit a photo of their creative work space and favorite tools of the trade. Through social media and digital photo sharing, this collaborative project aims to provide education, awareness, inspiration, and understanding about the spaces & places, settings, populations, and materials that art therapists, art therapy students, expressive arts therapists, and art organizations work in and use for their practice.

Types of photos or video that this project is looking for include:

1. **Images of your professional creative space:** At work, your internship, and on the go
2. **Commonly used art supplies and media:** In your art therapy work or internship with clients
3. **Favorite technique:** An art intervention or technique approach with individuals or in groups
4. **If your creative space has changed:** Before and after photos
5. **Images of your personal art-making space:** Where do you create *your* art?

When submitting content please follow the following guidelines:

- Digital photos should be sent in JPEG format (no larger than 2 MB per photo) and e-mailed to info@arttherapyalliance.org with the subject heading "Where We Create". Video submissions should be no more than 90 seconds in length and 10 MB also e-mailed to the same e-mail address. If your video file is larger than 10 MB or in length, please consider uploading to video sharing sites such as YouTube or Vimeo and then e-mail the Art Therapy Alliance your link to share. Photo submission limit for each category is 2-3 photos.
- Include your name, location (city, state, country), as well as a brief description about each photo submitted. **Please include the reference number of the *type*** of photo submitted, where the photo was taken, and what your relationship is to the photo being submitted. Please note The Art Therapy Alliance reserves the right to review submissions for appropriateness, including if submissions are in line with the concept of the project.
- If client, consumer, or patient artwork or photos are included in your submission, please do not include identifying information and obtain the proper release and permission prior to making your submission.

Spaces and Places: Where We Create will be open for submissions until May 31, 2012.

By submitting your photos to this project, you give Art Therapy Alliance, Gretchen Miller, and Magdalena Karlick, the right to reuse your images and information in research and publication.
